### **Item 1. Apologies for absence/introductions**

### **Item 4. Chair's Report**

This year has seen the eventual approval by the Scottish Government and Clackmannanshire Council of the Local Development Plan. The major issue for the Community Council has been the proposed housing development behind the bowling green site. Despite objections, the Reporter decided that the number of houses should remain at thirty-five (35). This was excellent news and showed that with the support of Clackmannanshire Council's elected members we were right in campaigning for this level of housing rather than the 160 houses in the original proposals from the Council.

We are now waiting for the developers to involve the community in the creation of a master plan for the site and to see some planning gain that the community can enjoy.

In addition, it is important that we as a community welcome the new residents and help them integrate. Hopefully many will wish to play important roles in village life. In our campaign to limit the number of houses to 35, the Muckhart Area Plan played a key role. It told us that the majority of the community wanted to see some organic growth but were concerned that a disproportionate large number of new houses would lead to a loss of village identity. This gave the Community Council a very strong lobbying position which was eventually successful.

The existing Muckhart Area Plan is now over six years old and a major initiative is the creation of a new one. A sub committee led by John Anderson with Margot McKerrell, Matthew Pease, Mireille Pouget, Mike Wilson and myself has been formed. We have made good progress and held an initial public meeting and are now in the process of consulting with local groups, businesses and societies. The first will be on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> September in the church with an environmental event on 10<sup>th</sup> October as well as a questionnaire which is currently being prepared. Thanks go to the whole team for all their hard work.

Finally, I would like to thank all Community Councillors for their hard work. Mike Wilson was co-opted on to the Council this year and has made a great contribution on road issues and the new Community Plan. I would also like to thank the office bearers for their high levels of commitment – the Community Council would not function so effectively without their efforts.
